#### **3. REGULATIONS**

The championship will be held according to the CISM and the International Parachuting Federation regulations.

## 4. CONDITIONS OF STAY

a. During their stay in AUSTRIA from 09 - 20 Aug the missions will be guests of the Austrian MoD. Board and lodging will be provided by the organizer free of charge. The costs for board and lodging for additional personnel travelling with the missions are to be paid by the latter.

b. Extra expenses, including laundry, telephone, telegrams, fax, drinks etc., must be paid by the consumer.

c. Expenses before 09 Aug and after 20 Aug must be covered by the respective mission.

d. Additional persons will not be accepted by the organization without explicit written request by the Chief of Delegation of the respective country and UNDER CONDITION of the written agreement of the Chief of the Austrian Delegation.

# **5. POINTS OF ARRIVALAND DEPARTURE**

a. By civil plane: Vienna International Airport

b. By military plane: Military Airport LANGENLEBARN

c. By train: Railwaystation ST. POLTEN

d. By bus or car: RAAB - Kaserne, KREMS/ MAUTERN (s. map)

## 6. TRANSPORTATION

The transportation costs to and from Austria are at the expense of each country. The transport from the place of arrival in Austria to the place of stay and also the transport during the championship and training will be assured by the organizer.

# 7. DRESS

Military dress for the official ceremonies especially for the Opening Ceremony and the Price Giving Ceremony is requested.

# 8. PASSPORTS, VISAS

For information on requirements, please contact the Austrian Embassy in your own country.

# 9. ANTI - DOPING CONTROL

Anti-doping control will be made in accordance with international and CISM regulations.

# **10. MEDICAL TREATMENT**

Foreign soldiers who participate in the World Championship may, in case of injury or illness, receive first aid free of charge in military medical institutions. The cost of received first aid in civilian medical institutions or the cost of further

treatment, be it in military or civilian institutions, is to be paid back by the home country of the respective individual.

# **11. ELIGIBILITY**

Competitors must be military personnel on active duty in the Armed Forces of their respective country with an up-to date military identity card in accordance with CISM Regulation 4.8.2 (Participation - Species).

# **12. REQUIRED ITEMS**

All teams have to provide the following items:
a. National Anthem recorded on tape or CD.
b. All purpose country flag approximately 3<sup>\*</sup>5<sup>-</sup> or 0,9 \* 1,52 m .
c. Flag standard 7ft or 2,10 m in length.
